# 9 To agree DDF Charity Aims and goals and discuss 2 year forward planning aims with Fundraising goal

Proposed purchase of the Spyglass **Endoscopy equipment** -to aid the diagnosis and management of biliary strictures. Currently patients have to go to Norwich for these procedures and it would be useful to provide these services locally. There would be an initial outlay for the equipment. HKL to find out costings, which may be around £50-60,000. The service would initially be for Suffolk patients. Money would be saved as currently they have to travel to Norwich.

It was unanimously agreed to proceed with this plan.

10 **Charity website** - Maintenance of this was initially free but now the use of the web-hosting server is at a cost. Marcel Kok is willing to continue to maintain the website which now needs updating. It was proposed that the DDF pays £100 per annum to Marcel Kok for the upkeep of the website.
